JOB DESCRIPTION:

Approx. 15 – 28 hours per week (summer season)

Under general supervision of the Aquatics Supervisor, Swim Instructor/Lifeguards will be responsible for the safety and rescue of patrons visiting the facility. Swim Instructor/Lifeguards will organize, lead, and teach swim lessons for all age groups and ability levels. Swim Instructor/Lifeguards perform emergency care as necessary and respond to unsafe conditions or potential hazards. Swim Instructor/Lifeguards observe swimmers, enforce regulations, and perform related work as required.

TYPICAL DUTIES PERFORMED:

(Examples do not include all duties, which may be assigned.)

- Ensure an excellent guest experience.
- Teach swimming skills and water exercises to all age groups.
- Maintain accurate records; prepare reports and written communication as needed.
- Identify and rescue person in distress or in danger of drowning; perform emergency care as necessary.
- Observe and supervise swimmers in the pool and areas surrounding the pool, identify, and prevent unsafe conditions and potential hazards.
- Work effectively with the public in explaining and enforcing pool rules and facility use in order to provide a safe and accident---free pool environment.
- Perform facility clean up and maintenance; inspect pool facilities; and report unsafe conditions.
- Plan, develop, conduct, supervise, and manage a wide variety of activities regarding the operation of the Aquatics Center.
- Adhere to College and departmental policies and procedures.
- Perform related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Must possess excellent customer service skills

Knowledge of: Policies, procedures, and regulations governing the conduct and safety of persons using aquatic equipment and facilities; lifesaving techniques; beginning through advanced swim strokes. Methods, material, and equipment involved in the maintenance and operation of swimming pools.

Ability to: Pass initial and follow---up tests regarding pool and safety procedures Swim with proficiency and endurance. Organize and direct activities and effectively teach aquatic skills. Read, understand, and carry out written and oral directions. Establish and maintain effective working relationships with the public, community groups, staff, and other agencies. Exercise good judgment, courtesy, and tact with staff and the public. Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs. and work varied shifts, including weekends.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE:

Possession of valid California Driver's license or California ID is required. Applicants must provide proof of Lifeguard certification by first day of employment. The Lifeguard certification must be obtained through the Aquatics Certification School.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

Applicants selected to continue in the hiring process must complete Aquatics Certification School. Completion of the Aquatics Certification School is required for hiring consideration.
